Financial Year-End important deadlines to note

December 31, 2023 tuition payments will be deposited on December 29, 2023 due to December 31 being a Sunday in order for this payment to be included on your 2023 income tax receipt.

All donations received up to and including December 31, 2023, will be included on your 2023 income tax receipt. Any donations postmarked up to and including December 31 will also be included on your 2023 income tax receipt. The mail will be picked up periodically throughout the Christmas break.

If you plan to e-transfer donations or tuition payments for year end consideration, these must be received by December 29 by noon in order for the deposit to happen before the new year.
